But celebrate my life

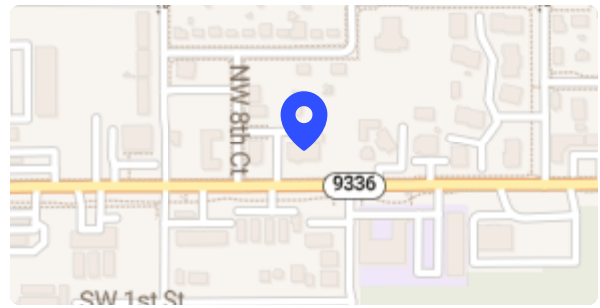

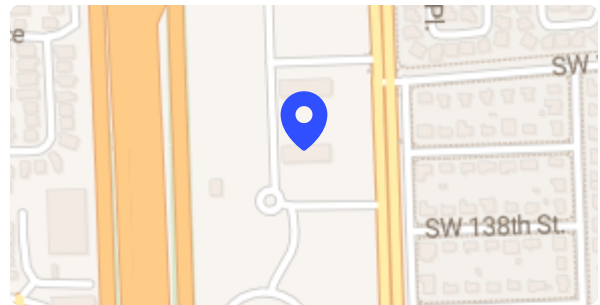
