## **Fernando Nunez**

DEC 30, 1934 - DEC 6, 2020

**M**r. Fernando Nuñez Sr. died peacefully in Miami, FL on December 6th, 2020 at the age of 86.

Mr. Nunez was born on May 30th, 1934 in Ciénaga, Magdalena, Colombia to his parents Maria Palma and Maximiliano Nuñez. He married Mariela Nunez on December 24th, 1956. The Nunez's moved to New York in the late 1960's, then to Rhode Island in the 1970's, and eventually settling in South Florida in 1980. Fernando worked as a plant manager in a printing company and Mariela worked as a seamstress in various factories. Mr. Nunez retired in 1997.

Fernando also owned and ran a successful DJ business "El Pito", with his sons Fernando and Hugo, throughout his life in Rhode Island and South Florida. He was a patient and supportive husband, father, and grand-father with a loving heart for his family and friends. Fernando was a social, active man who was deeply involved in music and family for the majority of his life. He would bring a calm presence brighten up a room with his smile and infamous jokes. His family and friends will always remember him as a kind, wise person.

Mr. Nunez is survived by his wife, Mariela Nuñez; his seven half-siblings; his sons and daughter-in-laws, Fernando and Astrid Nunez, and Hugo and Neisy Nunez; his daughter and son-in-law, Osiris and Jorge Lopez; and his six grandchildren. He is preceded in death by his brother, Hugo Nunez, and by one half-sibling.

A funeral is scheduled for 6:00 pm on December 9th, 2020. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, attendance to the funeral is by invite only. All are welcome to celebrate Fernando's life from a distance.

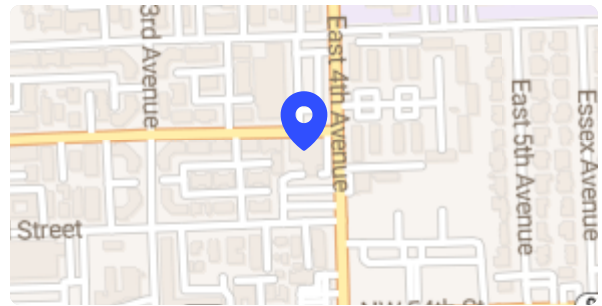
