**G**LUDOVATZ, THERESA K., beloved sister, sister-in-law, aunt, godmother, and friend, passed away peacefully at home on December 19, 2021, with her family and friends by her side. Born in Miami, FL on November 11th, 1949, Theresa (Terry) was the elder child of Lorenz Gludovatz and Beverly (Callahan) Gludovatz (both deceased). 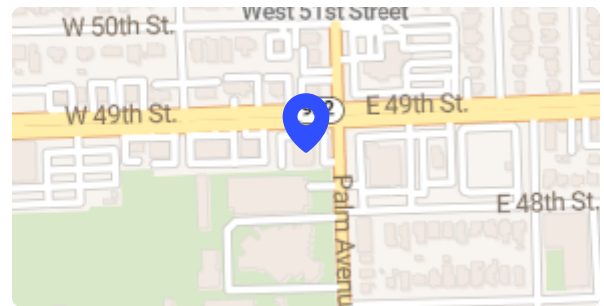

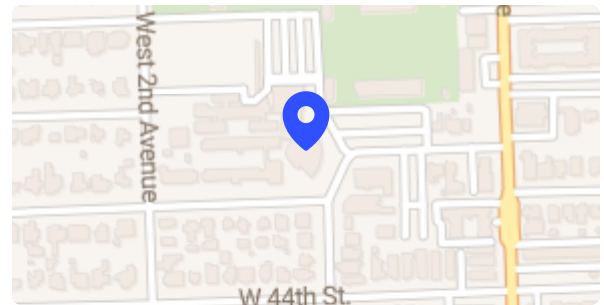
