Dominick was happiest feeding friends and family members his Italian delicacies, and his pizza and bruschetta will remain legendary. He will be greatly missed by his family and friends.

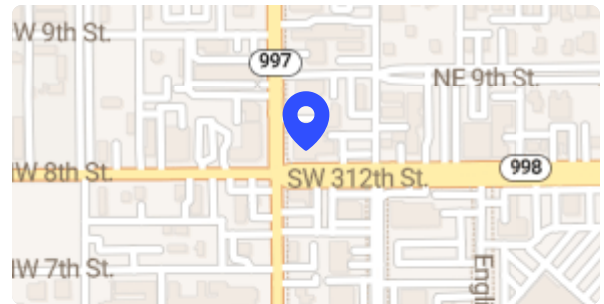

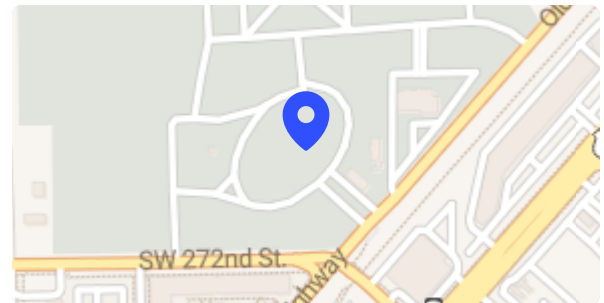
