He played amateur baseball with his brothers, his position was catcher. He earned a theology degree at the Salesian Brothers Seminary in Guanabacoa, Cuba. He worked as an agricultural inspector and at a travel agency. As a travel agent he helped prominent figures as well as the Pedro Pan children escape Communist Cuba. He also arranged the departure of his brothers, a sister, and nieces to the US before his own departure with my Mom, my sisters, my aunt and godfather, my grandmother, and yours truly. My Dad was involved in the Resistance to the Castro Regime in the early 60s and served time in prison as a political prisoner. Dad thanks for teaching me the difference between right and wrong. I will miss our conversations on sports and politics, but most of all I will miss seeing you.
